Pre-Conference Courses March 5-7

(NEW) BCP-100: Introduction to Business Continuity Planning

(March 6) New one-day course designed specifically for novices in the field of BCP. This course provides a thorough overview of the BCP process, from initial evaluation of risk to implementing and testing the plan.

(NEW) BCP-109: Public Relations and Crisis Coordination with Public Authorities (March 6)

This is a one-day course designed to offer direction in developing, coordinating evaluation and exercising plans to handle the media and other audiences during crisis situations. Communications will be a key to ensuring all stakeholders are kept informed on an as needed basis. The second half of the course assists in developing policies and procedures for coordinating response, continuity and restoration activities with local authorities.
