Pre-Conference Courses September 16-18

BCLE 100: Project Management Principles in Business Continuity Planning (Sept. 16) This course identifies the requirements and imperatives of project management methodologies required to develop an enterprise-wide Business Continuity Plan.

BCLE 200: Introduction to the Principles of Risk Management (Sept. 17) This course introduces the basic concepts of Risk Management and develops familiarity with the methodologies and models used in the Business Continuity Planning profession.

BCLE 300: Introduction to Business Impact Analysis (Sept. 18) This course introduces the reasons for and value of conducting a Business Impact Analysis. The student will understand methodologies, terms and definitions such as Mission Critical business processes, Recovery Time Objectives (RTO), Acceptable Exposure to Loss, etc.

DRP-501 A: Business Continuity Planning Review (Sept. 16-17) This two-day course provides a review for the CBCP exam, covering most elements of the contingency and recovery plan. CBCP exam included.

Post-Conference Courses September 22-24

BCLE-350: Business Impact Analysis (Sept. 22-24) This advanced course presents the Business Impact Analysis process and the importance of this element in the functional requirements phase of corporate contingency planning. Participants learn how to plan and successfully conduct a BIA project.

BCP-212: Risk Mitigation in Business Continuity Planning (Sept. 22-24) This course presents control and mitigation actions that can reduce the impact of unpreventable incidents resulting from wind, flood, earthquake, and fire. Highlighting the course are two workshops that demonstrate how prevention, control, and mitigation are an integral and cost effective part of a recovery plan.

BCP-213: Incident Command System for Corporations (Sept. 22-24) The Incident Command System (ICS) is a proven process for managing emergency response. Public agencies like FEMA, state emergency management agencies, and police and fire departments use ICS as their standard response model. As well, OSHA requires industry to use ICS. The model is a management system that provides consistent terminology, organization and operational guidelines for quickly processing information and mobilizing resources to deal with an event, no matter the type or size.

DRP-501 B: Business Continuity Planning Review (Sept. 22-24)

BCP-601: Master-Level Case Study Preparatory Course (Sept. 22-24) This course addresses all 10 areas of professional practice for business continuity planners and prepares the candidate for the Master Business Continuity Professional (MBCP) certification. See DRII web site for registration prerequisites.
